USCIS TO REJECT NEW APPLICATIONS FOR DACA AND LIMIT RENEWALS TO A 1-YEAR PERIOD

On July 28, 2020, the Department of Homeland Security released a new Memorandum regarding DACA applications in light of the Supreme Court's holding in Department of Homeland Security v. Regents of the University of California. It reiterates the current Presidential Administration's view that "the DACA policy, at a minimum, presents serious policy concerns that may warrant its full rescission."

In the interim, USCIS will:

- Reject applications for DACA from those who have never had DACA status before
- Reject applications for Advance Parole (absent extraordinary circumstances)
- DACA Renewals will be limited to 1 year, instead of 2 years

The language of the memorandum strongly suggests the Attorney General is considering rescinding DACA again, which the Supreme Court held is a valid and lawful action, provided sufficient reasoning is given for rescission of the program.
